


Chapter 11 Design Tools

Design Tool 11.1: What Matters to Our Team?

Directions for students: Use this process to decide on some useful guidelines that will help you work together smoothly during your STEM project.

- 1 Think of some times when you have worked on teams. On sticky notes, list the behaviors you liked in those you worked with during those team meetings. List one different behavior on each sticky note.
- 2 Share the behaviors you listed with your team members and place your sticky notes so others can see them. If you listed the same behavior as someone else, place your sticky note on top of the one it matches.
- 3 When everyone has finished sharing, talk about each behavior listed and what that might look like in a team meeting.
- 4 Agree as a team on the behaviors you all want to see happen on your team. List those below.

These behaviors will be your starting norms, or team guidelines. As you work together you may change them or add others to them.

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
